Terms and conditions for participating in aquaballet – Grades course students only

Grades course participants will take part in an aquaballet session at the Wellington Regional Aquatic Centre (WRAC) in Kilbirnie. Students will be taken to the Centre by a privately hired bus.

The most serious risks associated with swimming pools include slipping on wet surfaces, drowning and diving into shallow water. These risks will be managed by:

- Having a minimum ratio of 1 supervising adult per 8 students accompanying the group at all times
- Having a qualified life saver from the WRAC present while the students are in the water
- Supporting students to walk slowly and behave calmly at all times
- Prohibiting access to diving boards
- Supervising students when they dive from the edge of the pool

Students who are not confident in water, who are not able to swim or who are shorter than 1.2metres, will be provided with a platform to ensure they are able to stand with their head and shoulders above the water level.
