

TERMS AND CONDITIONS RAD Summer School January 2022

Courses available

- <u>Grades course 1</u>: 10-15 January 2022 and <u>Grades course 2</u>: 17-22 January 2022, for students 8-12 in RAD grades 3-5 or equivalent
- <u>Vocational course</u>: 17-22 January 2022 for students 11+ in RAD Intermediate Foundation Advanced 2 or equivalent
 - \circ In the vocational course, students will be able to choose from two options:
 - Option 1: Morning ballet and contemporary techniques classes followed by afternoon workshops in musical theatre, jazz and choreography
 - Option 2*: Morning ballet and contemporary technique classes followed by afternoon workshops in classical repertoire, pointe or boys' specific repertoire, RAD exam extension preparation and choreography (*students must have had 1 years' experience on pointe to register for this option)
- Teachers' course: 17-21 January 2022 (note Friday will be a half day)

Fees - All fees include \$50 nonrefundable registration fee

Grades: Earlybird (2 August – 31 October): \$490

Vocational: Earlybird (2 August – 31 October): \$500

Teachers: Earlybird (2 August – 31 October): \$650 (full week – 4.5 days); day registrations available from 1 October: \$195 per day; \$100 for Friday only. There is no day rate for Samantha Leeman's 1.5 day workshop – Tuesday 18 and Wednesday 19 January. Teachers must book the whole week or for both days. (no earlybird available for day registrations)

From 1 November: Grades \$540; Vocational \$550; Teachers \$750

There will be a 10% discount available to vocational students enrolling in both the NZ School of Dance Summer Intensive and the RAD vocational course. Please contact <u>info@rad.org.nz</u> before making payment.

Refunds

- A refund of 80% of the fee (excluding the registration fee) will be considered for cancellations on medical grounds and on receipt of a medical certificate up to 7 days prior to the course commencement.
- In limited situations on compassionate grounds, a refund of 80% of the fee (excluding the registration fee) will be considered for cancellations due to a family emergency up to 7 days prior to the course commencement. To apply, please contact the National Director: <u>info@rad.org.nz</u>
- There will be no refund for cancellations received less than 7 days prior to the course commencement.

COVID related refunds:

- Courses will take place uninterrupted, with social distancing and additional hygiene, if alert level 2 restrictions are imposed
- Courses will be cancelled for the period affected if alert level 3 or 4 restrictions are imposed
- A refund of 100% of the fee (excluding the registration fee) will be provided if the entirety of any course is cancelled due to alert level 3 or 4 restrictions being imposed
- Partial refunds of 16% of the fee (excluding the registration fee) will be provided for each day a course is cancelled due to alert level 3 or 4 restrictions being imposed

Terms and conditions for participating in circus arts – Grades course students only

Grades course participants will take part in a circus arts workshop with The Circus Hub There are some risks associated with circus arts that cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. Circus arts may involve a test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for physical injury such as cuts, bruises, sprains, strains, breaks and dislocations.

For this reason, The Circus Hub has developed a comprehensive <u>safety management plan</u>. By submitting the registration form, you agree that you have read and understood the risks involved and the safety management plan.

By submitting the registration form, you agree that, in the case of an injury that requires immediate and urgent medical attention, we may call an ambulance and have the student taken to Wellington Hospital.

Terms and conditions for participating in aquaballet – Grades course students only

Grades course participants will take part in an aquaballet session at the Wellington Regional Aquatic Centre in Kilbirnie. Students will be taken to the Centre by a privately hired bus.

The most serious risks associated with swimming pools include slipping on wet surfaces, drowning and diving into shallow water. These risks will be managed by:

- Having a minimum ratio of 1 supervising adult per 8 students accompanying the group at all times
- Having a qualified life saver present for each group while the students are in the water
- Supporting students to walk slowly and behave calmly at all times
- Prohibiting access to diving boards
- Actively discouraging students from diving from the edge of the pool

Students who are not confident in water, who are not able to swim or who are shorter than 1.2metres, will be provided with a platform to ensure they are able to stand with their head and shoulders above the water level.
